A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Health – Vital Records – Electronic Filing and Storage

- FOR the purpose of altering the date by which the Secretary of Health is required to establish a process by which death certificates can be filed electronically and requiring that the process allow all vital records to be filed electronically; requiring the Secretary to store vital records in a searchable electronic database; and generally relating to electronic filing and storage of vital records.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Health General
- 21 4-201.
- 22 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

- 1 (u) "Vital record" means a certificate or report of birth, death, fetal death, 2 marriage, divorce, dissolution or annulment of marriage, adoption, or adjudication of 3 paternity that is required by law to be filed with the Secretary.
- 4 4–203.
- 5 (a) The Secretary is charged with administering efficiently and uniformly this 6 subtitle throughout this State.
- 7 (b) (1) The Secretary shall:
- 8 (i) Establish appropriate methods and the necessary forms for 9 accurate registration of vital records;
- 10 (ii) On or before January 1, [2015] **2028**, establish a process by 11 which [death certificates] **VITAL RECORDS** can be filed electronically; [and]
- 12 (iii) Educate physicians, physician assistants, and nurse 13 practitioners regarding the process by which [death certificates] VITAL RECORDS can be 14 filed electronically; AND
- 15 (IV) STORE VITAL RECORDS IN A SEARCHABLE ELECTRONIC 16 DATABASE.
- 17 (2) The forms shall provide for the information that the Secretary needs for 18 proper registration and use of these vital records.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2024.
