FOR the purpose of establishing a Class M–F (Municipal Family Fun Center) alcoholic
beverages license in the 40th alcoholic beverages district in Baltimore City;

Class B beer, wine, and liquor license to a restaurant in a certain location;
authorizing a certain Class A license issued for a certain location to remain
