4 to seek relief in a certain manner if a party fails to comply with a subpoena; and
5 generally relating to the subpoena authority granted to the Human Relations
6 Commission of Anne Arundel County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Local Government**

15 **12–905.**

16 **(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.**

10 (I) THE COMMISSION MAY APPLY TO A CIRCUIT COURT IN ANY
11 COUNTY FOR AN ORDER REQUIRING THE ATTENDANCE AND TESTIMONY OF
12 WITNESSES AND THE PRODUCTION OF BOOKS, PAPERS, RECORDS, ELECTRONICALLY
13 STORED INFORMATION, DOCUMENTS, AND TANGIBLE PROPERTY; AND

14 (II) THE COURT MAY ISSUE AN ORDER REQUIRING THE
15 ATTENDANCE AND TESTIMONY OF THE WITNESS AND THE PRODUCTION OF THE
16 BOOKS, PAPERS, RECORDS, ELECTRONICALLY STORED INFORMATION, DOCUMENTS,
17 AND TANGIBLE PROPERTY:

18 1. AFTER NOTICE TO THE PERSON SUBPOENAED AS A
19 WITNESS OR DIRECTED TO PRODUCE BOOKS, PAPERS, RECORDS, ELECTRONICALLY
20 STORED INFORMATION, DOCUMENTS, AND TANGIBLE PROPERTY; AND

21 2. ON A FINDING THAT THE ATTENDANCE AND
22 TESTIMONY OF THE WITNESS OR THE PRODUCTION OF THE BOOKS, PAPERS,
23 RECORDS, ELECTRONICALLY STORED INFORMATION, DOCUMENTS, AND TANGIBLE
24 PROPERTY IS RELEVANT OR NECESSARY FOR THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE
25 COMMISSION.

26 (2) AN ORDER ISSUED BY THE COURT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
27 SHALL BE SERVED ON THE PERSON TO WHOM IT IS DIRECTED BY THE SHERIFF OR
28 DEPUTY SHERIFF.

29 (3) A FAILURE TO OBEY AN ORDER ISSUED BY THE COURT UNDER
30 THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE PUNISHED BY THE COURT AS CONTEMPT OF COURT.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
32 October 1, 2024.
