A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment – Tidal Wetlands – Construction of Piers**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, in making a decision on an application for a license or
4 permit to construct a pier, the Department of the Environment from considering any
5 vessel owned by the applicant as a condition for issuing the license or permit; and
6 generally relating to tidal wetlands and the construction of piers.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Environment**

15 **16–105.1.**

16 **IN MAKING A DECISION ON AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE OR PERMIT TO**
17 **CONSTRUCT A PIER, THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT CONSIDER ANY VESSEL OWNED BY**
18 **THE APPLICANT AS A CONDITION FOR ISSUING THE LICENSE OR PERMIT.**

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2024.
