Natural Resources - Submerged Aquatic Vegetation Surveys

- FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "aerial survey" for purposes of surveying submerged aquatic vegetation to include other surveys that use certain data encompass certain geographic areas and use certain methodologies; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to study and report on the implications and feasibility of using alternative methods other than an aerial survey to delineate SAV protection zones on or before a certain date; and generally relating to submerged aquatic vegetation surveys.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:



3	(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
4 5 6	(2) "SAV PROTECTION ZONE" MEANS AN AREA DELINEATED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PROTECTION FROM UPROOTING AND THE RESTORATION OF SUBMERGED AQUATIC VEGETATION.

8 9 10 11	(I) THE annual aerial SUBMERGED AQUATIC VEGETATION survey compiled by the Virginia Institute of Marine Sciences for the annual Bay-wide Submerged Aquatic Vegetation Mapping Program CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS; OR
12	(II) ANY OTHER SURVEY THAT USES DATA THAT:
13 14	1. Pertains to Encompasses the distribution of submerged aquatic vegetation in the State; and in:

25 26	(b) (1) In 2004 and every 3 years thereafter, the Department shall update the delineations of SAV protection zones that were completed in 2001.
27 28 29	(2) The updated delineations shall include areas where submerged aquatic vegetation has been mapped OR OBSERVED by [aerial] SAV surveys during at least 1 of the previous 3 years.

- 2 (g) This section may not be construed to affect the authority of the Department 3 to adopt any additional measures that the Department determines are necessary to protect 4 submerged aquatic vegetation beds in the waters of the State.

- 6 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 7 (n) "SAV Protection Zone" means an area of submerged aquatic vegetation as 8 mapped OR OBSERVED in [aerial surveys by the Virginia Institute of Marine Sciences] AN 9 SAV SURVEY, AS DEFINED IN § 4–1006.1 OF THIS TITLE, in 1 or more of the 5 years preceding the designation of an Aquaculture Enterprise Zone or an application for a lease under this subtitle.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- 13 (a) The Department of Natural Resources shall study and report on the 14 implications and feasibility of using alternative methods other than an aerial survey to 15 delineate SAV protection zones, as defined in § 4–1006.1 of the Natural Resources Article 16 as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.
- 17 (b) The report shall:
- 18 (1) analyze the current benefits and drawbacks of using an aerial survey 19 to delineate SAV protection zones;
- 20 (2) analyze the implications and feasibility of using alternative methods or technologies for delineating SAV protection zones;
- 22 (3) analyze whether alternative methods or technologies may be used more 23 frequently than every 3 years to delineate SAV protection zones; and
- 24 (4) analyze the benefits and drawbacks of increasing the look–back period 25 in § 4–1006.1(c) of the Natural Resources Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.
- 26 (c) On or before December 31, 2024 1, 2025, the Department of Natural Resources shall submit the report, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June $1,\,2024.$
