## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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### Apprenticeships in Licensed Occupations Act of 2024

FOR the purpose of requiring professional and occupational regulatory boards to issue 3 4 licenses, certifications, and registrations to individuals who complete an  $\mathbf{5}$ apprenticeship program that is established under certain provisions of this Act, pass 6 a certain examination, and pay a certain fee; authorizing the Maryland Department 7 of Labor to develop a standard apprenticeship program for a licensed occupation or 8 profession; requiring the Department to establish a workgroup to establish 9 group-sponsored apprenticeships in each occupation or profession for which a standard apprenticeship program is established; and generally relating to 1011 occupational and professional apprenticeships.

(3) A STANDARD APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER
THIS SECTION MAY NOT REQUIRE A MINIMUM AGE FOR PARTICIPATION THAT IS
GREATER THAN THE LEGAL MINIMUM AGE TO WORK IN THE STATE.

30(B)(1)A BOARD MAY REQUIRE AN EXAMINATION FOR AN APPRENTICE TO31OBTAIN LICENSURE ONLY IF THE BOARD REQUIRES ALL APPLICANTS FOR32LICENSURE TO PASS AN EXAMINATION.

1 HIGHER SCORE ON A LICENSURE EXAMINATION THAN IT REQUIRES FOR ALL OTHER 2 APPLICANTS.

8 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY 9 OUT THIS SUBTITLE.

22 THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE MARYLAND APPRENTICESHIPS IN 23 LICENSED OCCUPATIONS ACT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

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
