"In the wake of my brother Tameron's unexpected passing, we grappled with the idea of a conventional funeral, but it felt inadequate for a spirited soul like his. Tameron was a vibrant, talented, inspiring skateboarder and we realized we could honor his memory by transforming the local Truxtun Skatepark he frequented growing up. While some upgrades have been made, the park in its current form does not do justice to the community it served, our beautiful hometown of Annapolis, Maryland. That is why we decided to embark on a mission to revamp the park, create a vibrant space befitting Tameron's legacy and fostering a haven for future generations of skateboarders."
