The 100-year old reservoir site has been an ongoing project in need of substantial repairs. This project was funded \$500,000 in 2021 and \$200,000 in 2023 through MD Capital Grants. All engineering and design work is nearly completed on the project and the City is now ready to begin the construction/implementation phase of the project. This phase of the project will involve the installation of a 1.25 million gallon in-ground storage tank along with new system infrastructure to support the necessary on-going maintenance. Once the construction/implementation phase begins, the project must be fully funded and proceed to completion to minimize the impact on the city's water distribution system. This project is critical to ensuring the safety and integrity of our water storage facilities.
