10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)						

Quality Time Learning Center is an early learning center for children ages 6 weeks to first grade, age 6. For 35 years the organization has served the greater Montgomery County community including the last four years as a Maryland State Board of Education approved Maryland EXCELS, highest level program designation. The purpose of the organization is to provide an age-appropriate developmental program for young children including their social, emotional, physical, and cognitive development. The program seeks to develop and foster a safe, supportive, nurturing, multicultural, and inclusive environment in which to provide the highest quality early learning experiences for children and families.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

This project involves annexing the current operation at 8101 Georgia Ave. to provide an additional 220 childcare spaces for a total of 427 license spaces. Design, engineering, legal aspects, and all other preconstruction processes have been completed. A construction company is under contract with a limited scope at this time in order to align with and open for families by the beginning of the 2025 school year. The purpose of the project is to provide families and children with a well-rounded, safe, secure, and loving environment that fosters the desire for the community to support early learning programs. This expansion will provide the community that lacks quality programs for children with learning and development opportunities that are currently difficult to find, especially for infants and toddlers.
