Our facility consists of a lounge and a banquet hall each with men/women's bathrooms (4 total). The building was originally built in 1976 and since that time, ADA space requirements have increased to accommodate today's wheelchairs and mobility devices. The project will renovate all four bathrooms to include 1 ADA compliant bathroom in each of the locations. The project will make the facility accessible to all members of our growing community as the number of events held at this facility increases each year. Due to the recent closures of several large event facilities in Northern Anne Arundel County, the Severna Park Elks facility has seen a tremendous growth. The number of community organizations wanting to hold events at our facility has increased since Hella's, Michael's Fifth Avenue and others have closed down. Many weekends the lodge holds multiple events running, in some cases, concurrently.

Many community groups find need workspace at the Elks facility assemble/repackage items such as: Girl Scout Cookie Drive ... Boy Scout Poinsettia Flower Drive ... backpacks filled with school supplies ... clothing for area kids ... assembling gift bags for Veterans ... community drop off point for the annual Toys-For-Tots Christmas project.

Additional events currently held at the Severna Park Elks facility include ... Sundae Funday (an event held 4 times a year for developmentally delayed adults) ... area high school class reunions ... Weddings ... Quinceaneras ... Celebrations of Life ... Partners in Care Volunteer luncheon ... Anne Arundel County 100 Club Dinner (honoring local fire, police and first responders) ... 3 Northern Anne Arundel County Senior Center Holiday Parties ... Senior Center Summer Picnic ... and many other events.

Due to our organizational charter and tax status, some monies brought in by our organization must be used solely for charitable activities and cannot be used for this renovation project.

This grant would allow the Severna Park Elks to begin this much needed renovation project as soon as possible. This will meet the growing needs for an event space which is ADA compliant in Northern Anne Arundel County.
