10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)		
<p>St. Mary's Ryken (SMR) is a private Catholic, coeducational, college preparatory high school dedicated to academic excellence and personal student growth. SMRs 87-acre campus in Leonardtown, MD hosts students from 48 middle schools in five Southern MD counties. Students experience diverse and progressive opportunities in academics, fine arts, athletics, activities and campus ministry. By graduation, students are well prepared for college and committed to service and responsible citizenship. SMR partners with the Naval Air Station Patuxent River Educational Partnership Program, College of Southern MD and St. Mary's College of MD for enrichment opportunities. SMR is accredited by the Maryland State Department of Education. SMR is recognized as an independent Catholic high school by the Archdiocese of Washington.</p>		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The turf field and track installed 14 years ago by SMR was the first turf field in the county for all-weather outdoor activities. It has served thousands of youth in the tri-county area since its installation, who have benefitted through sports, summer camps, travel teams, Special Olympics, college games, movie nights, and countless other enrichment activities. The turf is in need of refurbishment to continue to serve thousands of youth from across the state including the SMR student body, students from other WCAC schools; more than 1200 elementary-school children participating in summer camp programs; youth club practice and games; and hundreds of community members with special needs through the Special Olympic national qualifying competition. The stadium provides a high- quality performance surface for these diverse athletes. The current facility is ADA compliant and planned upgrades will enhance the access and experience for communities with disabilities.
