<b>10. Description and Purpose of Organization</b> (Limit length to visible area)		
<p>Tuckahoe Equestrian Center (TEC) was incorporated in 1992 as a 501(C)(3) corporation. Per its Articles of Incorporation it will: 1-advance, develop and support competitive and educational programs for amateur competition in national equestrian sports, 2-assist the State of MD in developing the Tuckahoe Equestrian Center at Tuckahoe State Park as a venue for amateur equestrian competitions, 3-provide educational programs for children and amateur sportsmen dealing with all facets of care, training, breeding and competition of horses. Such activities include: horse shows, jousting (MDs state sport), dressage, cross-country, 4H, trail riding, jumping, clinics (riding, horse care, veterinary, trail safety equine management, therapeutic riding), 4-raise funds for use in the above exempt activities.</p>		

**11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

This project will support the activities of TEC by providing an ADA compliant bathroom/shower facility for those camping with their horses, attending clinics and youth group. Functions, participating in competitions and exhibitions and attending TEC organized events and fund raising activities. This facility will be a permanent capital improvement to the grounds and will remain the property of the State of MD, Department of Natural Resources. TEC members currently number over 400 from all areas of MD and from DE, PA, NJ, VA, WV. Events draw participants and spectators from far and wide and the project will serve the equine and non-equine community in competitive and educational events.
