Description of planned work items include: Roof--it's now fully repaired but we owe \$82k plus costs to assist with HVAC installation (\$90k); HVAC--planned/designed/ready to price and order new/modern system for entire building (\$180k) Bathrooms, plumbing and septic upgrades and improvements (\$130k): --switch from septic to public sewage --upgrade bathrooms and permanently fix often clogged and smelly restrooms; Building Exterior and Access (\$100k): --parking lot safety (painting/repairs, replace and add lighting --assess water run-off and potential damage --clean, re-pitch, and paint exterior walls as needed \*\*\*Some design work is already done, some will need to be reviewed or created. Work will begin as soon as possible once we complete required DGS paperwork.
