We seek capital to build a therapeutic greenhouse and garden for the iGROW program. I Gain Resiliency through Opportunity and Wellness (iGROW) is a nature-based, behavioral health program that engages participants through psychoeducation and ecotherapy practices (i.e. gardening, aromatherapy, etc.) that improve mental health. Usage of the urban agricultural farm and community garden components (i.e. plot utilization and education workshops) are open to the public and for the betterment of District 26. This capital project will fund the build and materials needed to sustain a community initiative at the intersection of healthcare and environment. Funds will support greenhouse build, fencing, soil testing, grading, water supply line system, 100-gallon container, compost area, etc. Garden structures will be built on land owned by lifelong partner, Artesian Enterprises, and will exceed 15 years of useful life. The community needs more holistic wellness experiences.
