## (House Bill 1053)

AN ACT concerning

## State Board of Nursing – Executive Director Qualifications – Study

FOR the purpose of <del>requiring the Maryland Department of Health to convene a stakeholder</del> workgroup to study <u>altering</u> the qualifications for the executive director of the State Board of Nursing; and generally relating to qualifications for the executive director of the State Board of Nursing.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

<u>Article – Health Occupations</u> <u>Section 8–204(d)</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> <u>(2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)</u> <u>(As enacted by Chapters 222 and 223 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2023)</u>

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Maryland Department of Health shall Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(1) convene a stakeholder workgroup to study the qualifications for the executive director of the State Board of Nursing, including by:

(i) discussing the functionality and effectiveness of the Board;

(ii) examining qualifications for executive directors of other State health occupations boards; and

(iii) examining the qualifications for executive directors of other state boards of nursing; and

(2) on or before December 1, 2024, submit a report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on the workgroup's findings and recommendations, if any, for statutory changes to the qualifications for the executive director of the State Board of Nursing.

## Article – Health Occupations

8-204.

- (d) The Board may:
  - (1) Employ a staff in accordance with the State budget;

- (2) Define the duties of its staff; and
- (3) Employ:

(i) <u>An executive director [who shall be a registered nurse with a</u> <u>minimum of a master's degree in nursing or the equivalent, in the judgment of the Board,</u> <u>in professional education and administrative experience]</u>; and

(ii) <u>A deputy director who shall assume the duties and authority of</u> the executive director in the absence of the executive director.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That <u>Section 1 of</u> this Act shall take effect July 1, <del>2024</del> <u>2025</u>, the termination date of Section 2 of Chapter 222 and Section 2 of Chapter 223 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2023. If the termination date of Section 2 of Chapter 222 and Section 2 of Chapter 223 is amended, Section 1 of this Act shall take effect on the termination of Section 2 of Chapter 222 and Section 2 of Chapter 223.

<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions of</u> <u>Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024</u>.
