Economic Matters

Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Part-Time Deputy Chief Inspector

This bill increases the annual salary of the part-time deputy chief inspector employed by the Anne Arundel County Board of License Commissioners from \$9,000 to \$18,000 and establishes that the deputy chief inspector must work 10 hours per week. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2024.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Anne Arundel County salary expenditures increase by \$9,000 annually beginning FY 2025. Anne Arundel County revenues are not affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The board is authorized to employ a part-time deputy chief inspector at an annual salary of \$9,000. Generally, each inspector must receive a monthly expense allowance of \$300 subject to the approval of the executive director.

Local Fiscal Effect: Anne Arundel County expenditures increase by \$9,000 annually beginning in fiscal 2025 due to the increase in annual salary for the part-time inspector under the bill.
