(House Bill 562)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County – ~~Republican~~ Political Party Central Committee – Elections

FOR the purpose of altering the number of members elected from each councilmanic district of Baltimore County to the Baltimore County Republican Party Central Committee; altering the number of members elected from each legislative district of Baltimore County to the Baltimore County Democratic Party Central Committee; and generally relating to the Baltimore County Republican Party Central Committee political party central committees in Baltimore County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
 Article – Election Law
 Section 4–203(c)(1) and (2)
 Annotated Code of Maryland
 (2022 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Election Law

4–203.

(c) (1) In Baltimore County, the Republican Party Central Committee shall consist of **[four] THREE** members elected from each councilmanic district in the county.

(2) For the Baltimore County Democratic Party Central Committee:

(i) [20] 10 members, [five] TWO from each district, shall be elected from legislative districts [6, 8, 10, and 11] 11A, 42A, 42B, 43B, AND 44A, each district being located wholly [within] IN Baltimore County;

(ii) [four] 12 members, FOUR FROM EACH DISTRICT, shall be elected from legislative [district 44B that is] DISTRICTS 7A, 11B, AND 44B, EACH DISTRICT BEING located wholly in Baltimore County; AND

(iii) [four] 18 members, SIX FROM EACH DISTRICT, shall be elected from [that part of] legislative [district 7 that is] DISTRICTS 6, 8, AND 10, EACH DISTRICT BEING located WHOLLY in Baltimore County[;

(iv) four members shall be elected from that part of legislative district 12 that is located in Baltimore County; and

(v) five members, of which two members shall be from delegate district 42A and three members shall be from delegate district 42B, shall be elected from legislative district 42 that is located wholly in Baltimore County].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
