

Chapter 792

(Senate Bill 746)

AN ACT concerning

Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Multiple Licenses – Golf Simulator Facilities

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Harford County to issue a Class GSF (golf simulator facility) license to a holder of a Class B license; clarifying that the Class GSF (golf simulator facility) license counts toward a certain total number of allowable Class B alcoholic beverages licenses a holder may be issued; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis

22–102.

This title applies only in Harford County.

22–1607.

(A) [The] **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE** Board may issue a maximum number of nine Class B licenses to the same person.

(B) (1) **THE BOARD MAY ISSUE ONE CLASS GSF (GOLF SIMULATOR FACILITY) LICENSE UNDER § 22–1003.2 OF THIS TITLE TO THE HOLDER OF ONE OR MORE CLASS B LICENSES.**

(2) A CLASS GSF (GOLF SIMULATOR FACILITY) LICENSE ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE TOTAL NUMBER OF LICENSES THAT MAY BE ISSUED TO THE SAME PERSON UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
