

Chapter 7

(House Bill 402)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County Board of Education – Student Member Scholarship – Increase

FOR the purpose of increasing the scholarship award for a student member of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education who completes a full term on the county board; and generally relating to the scholarship for the student member of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

3–2A–01.

- (a) The Anne Arundel County Board of Education consists of:
- (1) Seven nonpartisan elected members; and
 - (2) One student member.

3–2A–07.

(a) The president of the county board is entitled to receive \$17,000 annually as compensation, the vice president is entitled to receive \$16,000 annually as compensation, and, except for the student member, the other board members are entitled to receive \$15,000 each annually as compensation.

(b) A student member who completes a full term on the county board shall be granted a scholarship of ~~[\$8,000]~~ **\$15,000** to be applied toward the student's higher education costs.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2025.
