AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 780

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "**Delegate Kerr**" and substitute "**Delegates Kerr**, **Boyce**, **Healey**, **Lehman**, **and Ziegler**"; and in line 5, strike "investigation;" and substitute "<u>investigation</u>, subject to certain notice requirements; prohibiting the use of speed monitoring systems on certain urban State highways under certain circumstances;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 25, after "(b)" insert "(1)"; and in line 26, strike "(1)" and substitute "(1)".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 1, strike "(2)" and substitute "(III)"; and after line 4, insert:

"(2) THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION:

- (I) SHALL PUBLISH NOTICE OF A PROPOSED REDUCTION OF A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION ON ITS WEBSITE AND IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE JURISDICTION IN WHICH THE SPEED LIMIT DECREASE APPLIES AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE TAKING ACTION TO DECREASE THE SPEED LIMIT; AND
- (II) MAY NOT USE OR ALLOW THE USE OF A SPEED MONITORING SYSTEM TO ENFORCE SPEED LIMITS ON ANY PORTION OF AN URBAN HIGHWAY UNDER ITS JURISDICTION FOR WHICH THE SPEED LIMIT HAS BEEN

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DECREASED WITHOUT PERFORMING AN ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION FOR 6 MONTHS AFTER THE SPEED LIMIT DECREASE.".
