AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Senator King" and substitute "<u>Senators</u> King, Charles, Folden, James, Smith, Waldstreicher, and West".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 2, strike "or Vessel"; after line 2, insert:

"<u>(Sergeant Patrick Keep Act)</u>";

in line 4, strike "or vessel"; in lines 5 and 6, strike "or vessels"; in line 7, strike "repealing and reenacting, with amendments," and substitute "<u>adding to</u>"; and in line 9, strike "3–212.1" and substitute "<u>3–212.2</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 15 on page 1 through line 20 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

"<u>3–212.2.</u>

(A) <u>A PERSON MAY NOT DRIVE, OPERATE, OR CONTROL A MOTOR</u> <u>VEHICLE IN A CRIMINALLY NEGLIGENT MANNER.</u>

(B) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON ACTS IN A CRIMINALLY NEGLIGENT MANNER WHEN:

(1) THE PERSON SHOULD BE AWARE, BUT FAILS TO PERCEIVE, THAT THE PERSON'S CONDUCT CREATES A SUBSTANTIAL AND UNJUSTIFIABLE RISK TO THE SAFETY OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY; AND

(2) THE FAILURE TO PERCEIVE CONSTITUTES A GROSS DEVIATION FROM THE STANDARD OF CARE THAT WOULD BE EXERCISED BY A REASONABLE PERSON.

(C) IT IS NOT A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION FOR A PERSON TO DRIVE, OPERATE, OR CONTROL A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A NEGLIGENT MANNER AS DEFINED IN § 21–901.1 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

(D) <u>A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS</u> GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.".
