in line 19, after "SECTOR;" insert "<u>AND</u>"; and strike beginning with "; AND" in line 28 down through "IMPROVEMENTS" in line 31.

On page 5, in line 4, strike "MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT" and substitute "<u>APPROPRIATE LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGER</u>"; strike beginning with the colon in line 11 down through "SERVES" in line 12 and substitute "<u>SERVES</u>"; strike beginning with "; OR" in line 12 down through "OPERATIONS" in line 14; in line 20, strike "ADOPT" and substitute "<u>COMMIT TO ADOPTING</u>"; in the same line, strike ", SIMILAR TO" and substitute "<u>AND BEGIN PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTING THE ZERO-TRUST APPROACH, AS APPROPRIATE FOR EACH SYSTEM, MODELED AFTER"; in line 24, strike "EACH JULY 1" and substitute "<u>EVERY 2 YEARS</u>"; in line 25, strike "ENGAGE WITH A THIRD PARTY TO"; in the same line, strike "AN" and substitute "<u>A MATURITY</u>"; in the same line, strike "THE" and substitute "<u>ITS CYBERSECURITY PROGRAM FOR</u>"; and strike beginning with "DEVICES" in line 26 down through the second "SYSTEM" in line 27.</u>

On page 6, in line 1, strike "(A)"; in line 6, strike "§ 9-2705(B)(4)" and substitute "§ 9-2705(B)(3)"; strike in their entirety lines 10 through 18, inclusive; and in line 23, after "SYSTEM" insert "<u>OR OPERATIONAL TECHNOLOGY SYSTEM</u>".

On page 7, in line 8, after "**THE**" insert "**DEPARTMENT AND THE OTHER**"; after line 17, insert:

ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2026, AND EVERY 2 YEARS THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE

(3) <u>"COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §</u> 9–401 OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE.

(4) (1) "CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 1–101 OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE.

- (II) <u>"CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE" INCLUDES:</u>
 - 1. <u>A COMMUNITY SEWERAGE SYSTEM; AND</u>
 - **<u>2.</u>** A COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM.

(5) <u>"OPERATIONAL TECHNOLOGY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §</u> 9–2701 OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE.";

in line 23, after "system" insert "<u>, OPERATIONAL TECHNOLOGY</u>,"; and in line 24, after "INFRASTRUCTURE" insert "<u>, INCLUDING ANY RECORDS OF A COMMUNITY WATER</u> <u>SYSTEM OR COMMUNITY SEWERAGE SYSTEM</u>".
