"<u>BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,</u> <u>Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings</u> <u>Section 3-8C-12</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2020 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 8, strike "That:" and substitute "<u>That the Laws of Maryland</u> <u>read as follows:</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 9 through 18, inclusive, and substitute:

"Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

<u>3-8C-12.</u>

(A) On or before November 1 of each year, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Maryland shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on each Truancy Reduction Pilot Program established under this subtitle.

(B) THE REPORT REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE:

(1) <u>The number of Truancy Reduction Pilot Programs</u> <u>ESTABLISHED IN THE STATE;</u>

(2) THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS IN EACH TRUANCY REDUCTION PILOT PROGRAM;

(4) <u>RECOMMENDATIONS TO IMPROVE THE FUNCTION OF</u> <u>CURRENT TRUANCY REDUCTION PILOT PROGRAMS.</u>".
