AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 372  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Mautz**” and substitute “**Mautz, Ellis, Hayes, Hershey, C. Jackson, Ready, and A. Washington**”; in line 11, after “rate;” insert “requiring the Maryland Health Care Commission to submit a certain report regarding telehealth every certain number of years;”; and after line 17, insert:

“BY adding to

Article – Health – General

Section 19–108.6

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2023 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 8, insert:

“19–108.6.

ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EVERY 4 YEARS, BEGINNING IN 2026, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT INCLUDES:

(1) ADVANCES OR DEVELOPMENTS IN THE AREA OF TELEHEALTH, INCLUDING:

(I) EVOLVING MODALITIES OF TELEHEALTH DELIVERY; AND

(II) CHANGES IN THE COSTS OF DELIVERING TELEHEALTH SERVICES; AND

(2) ANY FINDINGS OR RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION.”.
