AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 774

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, after the first “of” insert “requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission to designate certain private institutions of higher education as hunger-free campuses; prohibiting certain private institutions of higher education from being eligible to receive grant funding under the Hunger-Free Campus Grant Program;”; strike beginning with the second “the” in line 4 down through “administer” in line 9; in line 11, strike “without” and substitute “with”; in line 13, strike “through 11-1703” and substitute “and 11-1703 through 11-1706”; in line 16, strike “with” and substitute “without”; and in line 18, strike “11-1704 through 11-1706” and substitute “11-1702”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 in lines 3, 5, and 23, on page 3 in lines 26, 27, 30, and 32, on page 4 in line 3, and on page 5 in line 17, in each instance, strike “public”.

On page 4, in line 14, after “(a)” insert “**(1)**”; in lines 16 and 18, strike “(1)” and “(2)”, respectively, and substitute “**(I)**” and “**(II)**”, respectively; in line 17, strike “, INCLUDING AT LEAST \$25,000 IN CASH OR IN-KIND CONTRIBUTION”; after line, 18 insert:

“(2) NOTWITHSTANDING DESIGNATION AS A HUNGER-FREE CAMPUS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, A 4-YEAR OR 2-YEAR PRIVATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION OR A REGIONAL HIGHER EDUCATION CENTER OPERATED BY A PRIVATE NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE PROGRAM.”;

in line 19, strike “**(1)**”; and strike in their entirety lines 20 through 28, inclusive.

On page 5, strike beginning with the comma in line 14 down through “**PROGRAM**” in line 15; in line 19, strike the brackets; and strike beginning with the semicolon in line 20 down through “**PROGRAMS**” in line 22.
