AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 385
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 4 and 5, strike “to whom the tip will be allocated” and substitute “that the tip is for employees”; and in line 5, strike “by default;” and substitute “or a “no-tip” option, subject to certain conditions; requiring the Maryland Department of Labor and the Division of Consumer Protection in the Office of the Attorney General to make certain information available on the agencies’ public websites;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 17, strike “**JANUARY**” and substitute “**JULY**”; in line 20, strike “**ON THE SAME SCREEN**”; in lines 21 and 22, strike “**INFORMATION DISCLOSING TO WHOM THE TIP WILL BE ALLOCATED**” and substitute “**ON THE SAME SCREEN OR ON A PREVIOUS SCREEN, A NOTICE DISCLOSING THAT THE TIP IS FOR EMPLOYEES**”; in line 23, strike “**A**” and substitute “**ON THE SAME SCREEN, A**”; in the same line, strike “**BY DEFAULT**” and substitute “**OR A “NO-TIP” OPTION**”; in lines 27 and 28, strike “**THE DIVISION OF CONSUMER PROTECTION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THIS SECTION**” and substitute “**THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO PAYMENT TRANSACTIONS:**”

(1) FOR GOODS OR SERVICES PROVIDED TO CUSTOMERS SEATED AT A TABLE OR BAR; OR

(2) MADE BY A CUSTOMER FOR GOODS OR SERVICES:

(1) THROUGH A CUSTOMER’S MOBILE DEVICE; OR

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(II) ONLINE;

and after line 28, insert:

“(E) THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND THE DIVISION OF CONSUMER PROTECTION IN THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL MAKE INFORMATION ABOUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION AVAILABLE ON THE AGENCIES’ PUBLIC WEBSITES.”.

On page 3, in line 1, strike “(E)” and substitute “(F)”; and in line 5, after “ARTICLE” insert “, EXCEPT §§ 13-408 AND 13-411 OF THIS ARTICLE”.
