AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 505
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute:

“Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard – Renaming and Alterations”;

strike beginning with “altering” in line 5 down through “standard;” in line 6; strike beginning with “altering” in line 8 down through “Act;” in line 26; and in line 27, strike “, offshore wind energy,”.

On page 2, in line 19, strike “7-704.1(c)(6), (e)(1)(xiii), and (f)(1)(iii)” and substitute “7-704.1(e)(1)(xiii)”; in line 26, strike “7-701(a), 7-703(c), 7-704.1(f)(2), and 7-704.4(c)(1)” and substitute “7-701(a), 7-703(c), and 7-704.4(c)(1)”; and strike in their entirety lines 31 and 32 and substitute:

“Section 7-701(c) and (d) and 7-703(g)”.

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 35 on page 2 through line 5 on page 3, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 23 on page 4 through line 5 on page 5, inclusive.

On pages 5 and 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 15 on page 5 through line 5 on page 6, inclusive.

On page 6, in lines 6 and 13, in each instance, strike the first set of brackets; in line 10, strike the brackets; and in lines 6, 10, and 13, strike “**(4)**”, “**(5)**”, and “**(6)**”, respectively.

On pages 17 and 18, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 17 through line 7 on page 18.

On pages 18 and 19, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 12 on page 18 through line 18 on page 19, inclusive.

On page 23, in lines 15 and 21, in each instance, strike the bracket.

On pages 29 through 44, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 28 on page 29 through line 2 on page 44, inclusive.

On page 44, strike in their entirety lines 11 through 15, inclusive; in lines 16 and 19, strike “7.” and “8.”, respectively, and substitute “6.” and “7.”, respectively.
