### AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 905

(First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Woods" and substitute "Woods, Pena-Melnyk, Cullison, Bhandari, Hill, S. Johnson, Kaiser, Martinez, Rosenberg, Woorman, and Ross".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 27, strike "1."; and in line 28, strike "OR".

On page 3, in line 1, strike "2." and substitute "(VI)"; in the same line, after "A" insert "STAFF"; strike beginning with ", IF" in line 1 down through "HOSPITAL" in line 2 and substitute "WHO IS NOT A HOSPITAL EMPLOYEE OR ADMINISTRATOR"; in line 3, strike "(VI)" and substitute "(VII)"; strike beginning with "FOR" in line 7 down through "SETTING" in line 8 and substitute "THAT MEETS PATIENT NEEDS"; and strike beginning with "(1)" in line 9 down through "STANDARDS" in line 22 and substitute "WHEN DEVELOPING A CLINICAL STAFFING PLAN, THE CLINICAL STAFFING COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIDER:

- (1) EXISTING STAFFING LEVELS;
- (2) METHODS TO SECURE COVERAGE NEEDS AS NECESSARY;
- (3) EXISTING GAPS IN STAFFING AND HOW TO ADDRESS THE GAPS;
- (4) ANY AVAILABLE EVIDENCE-BASED STAFFING STANDARDS;

AND

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# (5) A SCHEDULE FOR PERIODIC REVIEW OF THE STAFFING PLAN".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 13, strike "**2026**" and substitute "**2027**".

On page 5, in line 3, after "UNIT;" insert "AND"; strike beginning with "; AND" in line 5 down through "WEBSITE" in line 7; after line 11, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that, beginning on or before July 1 each year, beginning in 2029, the Maryland Hospital Association shall:

- (1) compile reports provided by each hospital that summarize how the hospital's clinical staffing committee has addressed safe hospital staffing through the hospital's clinical staffing plan during the immediately preceding year; and
- (2) provide the reports in a single transmittal, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee.";

and in lines 12, 15, and 18, strike "2.", "3." and "4.", respectively, and substitute "3.", "4.", and "5.", respectively.
