AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 386

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Woorman**” and substitute “**Woorman, Pena-Melnyk, Cullison, Alston, Bhandari, Hill, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kaiser, Kerr, Lopez, Martinez, Rosenberg, Szeliga, Taveras, and Ross**”; in line 8, after “State;” insert “authorizing the Department and the Maryland Department of Health to list additional PFAS chemicals based on certain new information;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 9, strike “**THAT**” and substitute “:

(I) THAT CONTAIN”;

in line 10, after “**SUBSTANCES**” insert “**; AND**

(II) OF WHICH THE CHEMICAL COMPOSITION INCLUDES:

1. R-(CF₂)-CF(R')R”, WHERE BOTH THE CF₂ AND CF MOIETIES ARE SATURATED CARBONS;

2. R-CF₂OCF₂-R', WHERE R AND R' CAN EITHER BE F, O, OR SATURATED CARBONS; OR

3. CF₃C(CF₃)R'R”, WHERE R' AND R'” CAN EITHER BE F OR SATURATED CARBONS”;

and in lines 16 and 20, in each instance, strike “**2026**” and substitute “**2032**”.

On page 4, in line 1, strike “**2026**” and substitute “**2032**”; in line 4, strike “**2027**” and substitute “**2032**”; in line 6, strike “**2028**” and substitute “**2032**”; and after line 7, insert:

“(F) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION AND AGREEMENT WITH THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, MAY LIST ADDITIONAL PFAS CHEMICALS BASED ON:

- (1) NEW AND EMERGING HEALTH IMPACT DATA; AND**
- (2) EVOLUTION IN THE NEEDS, USES, AND AVAILABILITY OF ALTERNATIVES.”.**
