AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1066
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Guzzone” and substitute “, Guzzone, Pena-Melnyk, Cullison, Alston, Bagnall, Hill, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kaiser, Kipke, Lopez, Martinez, Rosenberg, Taveras, Woods, Woorman, and Ross”; strike beginning with “Membership” in line 2 down through “and” in line 3; strike beginning with “altering” in line 4 down through “Access;” in line 5; in line 5, after “Commission” insert “on Behavioral Health Care Treatment and Access”; and in line 16, strike “13-4803 and”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 through 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 1 on page 2 through line 7 on page 5, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 6, in line 16, strike “AND” and substitute:

“(2) EVALUATE AND REVIEW THE DEPARTMENT’S REGULATIONS ON THE STANDARDS FOR THE DISCHARGE OF PATIENTS FROM SUBSTANCE USE TREATMENT PROGRAMS TO ASSESS WHETHER THE STANDARDS ADEQUATELY CONSIDER THE PATIENT’S MENTAL HEALTH OR SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER DIAGNOSIS AND THE IMPACT OF THE DISCHARGE STANDARDS ON THE PATIENT; AND”;

in line 17, strike “(2)” and substitute “(3) (1)”; and in line 20, after “STATE” insert “; AND”

(II) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON CHANGES TO STATE LAWS, POLICIES, AND PRACTICES RELATED TO THE DISCHARGE OF PATIENTS FROM SUBSTANCE USE TREATMENT PROGRAMS TO CONSIDER THE PATIENT'S MENTAL HEALTH OR SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER DIAGNOSIS IN MAKING AN APPROPRIATE PLACEMENT".
