AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 367

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Young**” and substitute “**Young, Alston, Bagnall, Bhandari, Cullison, Guzzone, Hill, S. Johnson, Kaiser, Kerr, Lopez, Pena–Melnik, Rosenberg, Taveras, White Holland, Woods, and Woorman**”; in line 10, after “to” insert “prominently”; strike beginning with “list” in line 10 down through “requirements” in line 11 and substitute “statement that an applicant may not be required to provide additional evidence of English proficiency under certain circumstances”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 11, after “SHALL” insert “PROMINENTLY”; strike beginning with “LIST” in line 11 down through “REQUIREMENT” in line 13 and substitute “STATEMENT THAT AN APPLICANT MAY NOT BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY IF THE APPLICANT HOLDS A VALID, UNRESTRICTED LICENSE, CERTIFICATION, OR REGISTRATION FROM ANOTHER STATE THAT REQUIRES EVIDENCE OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY FOR LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION, OR REGISTRATION”.
