AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1467  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert “EMERGENCY BILL”; in the sponsor line, strike “**Hornberger**” and substitute “**Behler**”; in line 2, after “**Districts –**” insert “Anne Arundel County”; in line 7, after “district” insert “in Anne Arundel County”; in line 8, after “activities;” insert “providing that the entity administering a shore erosion control district may, subject to certain requirements, use tax funds for the maintenance, repair, or reconstruction of an existing shore erosion control project;”; in line 12, strike “and 21–207”; in line 17, strike “and” and substitute a comma; and in the same line, after “21–206” insert “, and 21–207”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 22 and 24, strike “**(I)**” and “**(II)**”, respectively; in line 21, strike the colon; and in line 23, strike the semicolon.

On page 3, in line 4, after “**DISTRICT**” insert “IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY”; in line 6, after “**PROJECT**” insert “IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY”; in the same line, strike “**OR**”; in line 7, after “**PROJECT**” insert “IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY; OR”

**(IV) THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PROJECT IN A DISTRICT IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY**;

after line 13, insert:

**“(C) (1) THE ENTITY ADMINISTERING A SHORE EROSION CONTROL DISTRICT MAY USE TAX FUNDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, OR RESTORATION OF AN EXISTING PROJECT WITHOUT A PETITION.**

**(2) THE ENTITY ADMINISTERING A SHORE EROSION CONTROL DISTRICT SHALL CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE USING TAX FUNDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, OR RESTORATION OF AN EXISTING PROJECT.**

**(3) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO ANY EXISTING SHORELINE EROSION CONTROL PROJECT WITHIN THE DISTRICT, REGARDLESS OF THE INITIAL SOURCE OF FUNDING.**;

after line 14, insert:

**“(A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.”;**

in lines 15 and 27, strike “(a)” and “(b)”, respectively, and substitute “**(B)**” and “**(C)**”, respectively; and strike beginning with “shall” in line 29 down through “2025” in line 30 and substitute “is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted”.
