AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1527

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, before "**Illegal**" insert "**Prince George's County**—"; in line 4, strike "requiring each county" and substitute "authorizing Prince George's County"; in the same line, after "certain" insert "pilot"; in line 9, after "circumstances;" insert "authorizing the governing body of Prince George's County to refer unpaid fines to the Central Collection Unit of the Department of Budget and Management for collection; authorizing fines collected under a certain program to be used for a certain purpose;"; in line 13, strike the second "and"; and in the same line, after "(2)" insert ", and (h)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 30, insert:

- "(h) A unit that supervises State property shall:
- (1) establish and maintain receptacles for the disposal of litter at appropriate locations where the public frequents the property;
- (2) post signs directing persons to the receptacles and serving notice of the provisions of this section; and
- (3) otherwise publicize the availability of litter receptacles and the requirements of this section.".

On page 3, in line 6, strike "Fines" and substitute "(I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, FINES"; strike beginning with the colon in line 6 down through "(I)" in line 7; in line 8, strike "; AND" and substitute a period;

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in line 9, after "(II)" insert "FINES COLLECTED IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL BE USED TO PAY FOR:

- 1. <u>MAINTENANCE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE</u>
 PILOT PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (K) OF THIS SECTION;
- 2. <u>LITTER RECEPTACLES AND POSTING SIGNS THAT</u>
 ARE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (H) OF THIS SECTION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES
 RELATED TO THE REMOVAL OR CONTROL OF LITTER;
- 3. THE REMOVAL OR CONTROL OF LITTER, LITTER
 REMOVAL PROGRAMS, OVERSIGHT, AND OPERATIONS PERFORMED BY THE UNIT
 THAT SUPERVISES STATE PROPERTY; AND

in line 12, strike "EACH COUNTY SHALL" and substitute "(1) THE GOVERNING BODY FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MAY"; in the same line, after the first "A" insert "PILOT"; in line 14, strike "(1)" and substitute "(I)"; in line 15, after "SECTION" insert "OCCURRING IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY"; strike line 16 in its entirety and substitute:

"(II) RECEIVE HALF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF ANY FINES COLLECTED";

after line 18, insert:

"(2) IF A PERSON FINED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PAY
THE FINE, THE GOVERNING BODY OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MAY REFER

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THE AMOUNT OF THE UNPAID OUTSTANDING FINE TO THE CENTRAL COLLECTION UNIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT.";

and in line 22, after the period insert "This Act shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of September 30, 2030, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
