# AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 147

(Third Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike lines 2 and 3 in their entirety and substitute:

## "Education - Student Personal Electronic Device Use Policy - Required";

strike beginning with "requiring" in line 4 down through "hours" in line 11 and substitute "requiring the State Department of Education to develop guidelines for a policy on student use of personal electronic devices during school hours; requiring county boards of education, in consultation with students, parents, teachers, and school personnel, to develop and adopt a policy that limits students from using personal electronic devices during school hours except under certain circumstances; and generally relating to county boards of education and a personal electronic device use policy for students"; and in line 14, strike "7–136" and substitute "4–147".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 1, strike "7–136." and substitute "4–147."; in line 4, strike "SMARTGLASSES" and substitute "ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICE THAT IS CAPABLE OF CONNECTING TO A SMARTPHONE OR A CELLULAR OR WI-FI NETWORK"; strike in their entirety lines 5 through 20, inclusive, and substitute:

- "(B) THE DEPARTMENT, IN COLLABORATION WITH STAKEHOLDERS, SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR A POLICY ON STUDENT USE OF PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES DURING SCHOOL HOURS, INCLUDING:
- (1) MODEL POLICY OPTIONS FOR COUNTY BOARDS TO USE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF A POLICY;

- (2) CONSIDERATIONS FOR STUDENTS IN DIFFERENT GRADE LEVELS;
- (3) CONSIDERATIONS FOR LEGAL EXEMPTIONS AND ACCOMMODATIONS FOR STUDENTS; AND
- (4) RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE LIMITATION OF STUDENT USE OF PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES DURING SCHOOL HOURS.
- (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT, IN COLLABORATION WITH STAKEHOLDERS, MAY PERIODICALLY UPDATE THE GUIDELINES DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
  - (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY:
- (I) <u>COLLECT INFORMATION ON EACH COUNTY BOARD'S</u>
  PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICE USE POLICY; AND
- (2) USE THE INFORMATION COLLECTED TO DEVELOP BEST PRACTICES AND INFORM THE PERIODIC REVIEW OF THE GUIDELINES.
- (D) (1) EACH COUNTY BOARD, IN CONSULTATION WITH PARENTS, TEACHERS, STUDENTS, AND SCHOOL PERSONNEL, SHALL DEVELOP AND ADOPT A POLICY THAT LIMITS A STUDENT FROM USING A PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICE DURING SCHOOL HOURS.
  - (2) THE POLICY ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL:

## (I) PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS:";

in lines 21, 23, and 25, strike "(1)", "(2)", and "(3)", respectively, and substitute "1.", "2.", and "3.", respectively; in line 26, strike the period and substitute a semicolon; and strike lines 27 through 30 in their entirety and substitute:

- "(II) BE PRINTED IN THE STUDENT HANDBOOK;
- (III) BE PROVIDED TO SCHOOL STAFF AND PERSONNEL; AND
- (IV) BE REVIEWED AND UPDATED EVERY 2 YEARS.".
