On page 2, after line 10, insert:

"(ff) (1) <u>A person convicted of a violation of subsection (j) of this section while</u> operating a commercial motor vehicle in Anne Arundel County is subject to:

- (i) For a first offense, a fine of \$100;
- (ii) For a second offense, a fine of \$250; and
- (iii) For a third or subsequent offense, a fine of \$500.

(2) <u>A person convicted of a violation of subsection (u) or (dd) of this</u> section is subject to a fine of \$25.
