Section 1 of this Act shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of Chapters 80 and 81 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2021. If that termination provision takes effect, Section 1 of this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision. Section 2 of this Act shall remain effective through September

30, [2026] **2029**, and, at the end of September 30, [2026] **2029**, Section 2 of this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.";
