AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 29, insert:

“(K) **BEGINNING ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2025, AND EACH OCTOBER 1 THEREAFTER, THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE STATUS OF ACTIVITY OF THE OPIOIDS ENFORCEMENT UNIT, INCLUDING:**

- (1) **THE NUMBER OF INVESTIGATIONS TAKING PLACE;**
- (2) **THE NUMBER OF LAWSUITS FILED; AND**
- (3) **THE DISPOSITION OF LAWSUITS FILED.”;**

and in line 31, after “2025.” insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of June 30, 2029, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
