AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 798

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Ziegler**” and substitute “**Ziegler, Pena-Melnyk, Cullison, Alston, Bagnall, Bhandari, Chisholm, Guzzone, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kerr, Kipke, Lopez, M. Morgan, Reilly, Rosenberg, Ross, and Szeliga**”; and in line 6, after “public;” insert “requiring the dashboard to include links to the State, county, or municipal websites that provide access to additional information on the use of opioid-related settlement funds;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 15, strike “**THE**” and substitute “**IF THERE IS A STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPAL WEBSITE THAT PROVIDES ACCESS TO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON THE USE OF OPIOID-RELATED SETTLEMENT FUNDS BY THE STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY, THE**”; strike beginning with “**INFORMATION**” in line 15 down through “**FUND**” in line 17 and substitute “**A LINK TO THE STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPAL WEBSITE**”; in line 18, after “**(1)**” insert “**THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY THAT:**

(I) COMPLIES WITH REPORTING REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED IN AN OPIOID-RELATED SETTLEMENT; AND

(II) SHARES THE DATA IN THE REPORTS REQUIRED UNDER AN OPIOID-RELATED SETTLEMENT WITH THE APPROPRIATE STATE ENTITY.

in line 22, strike “**(2)**” and substitute “**(3)**”; in line 23, strike “**(1)**” and substitute “**(2)**”; and in line 25, strike “**(3)**” and substitute “**(4)**” **THE DEPARTMENT SHALL UPLOAD OPIOID-RELATED SETTLEMENT INFORMATION SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT BY A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE TERMS OF AN OPIOID-RELATED SETTLEMENT.**
