AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 168

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Environmental Justice in Confined Aquatic Disposal Act" and substitute "Confined Aquatic Disposal Cells – Construction – Moratorium"; strike beginning with "within" in line 5 down through "community" in line 6 and substitute "during a certain time period"; in line 8, strike "within a certain distance of a residential overburdened community" and substitute "during a certain time period"; and strike in their entirety lines 10 through 14, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 23 on page 1 through line 24 on page 2, inclusive.

On page 3, strike beginning with "AN" in line 17 down through "WATER" in line 19 and substitute "A DREDGED MATERIAL MANAGEMENT OPTION WHERE A DEPRESSION OR CELL IS EXCAVATED INTO THE BOTTOM OF A BODY OF WATER, ANY SAND EXCAVATED IS REUSED IN A BENEFICIAL MANNER, AND THE DEPRESSION OR CELL IS FILLED IN WITH DREDGED MATERIALS, INCLUDING DREDGED MATERIALS FROM BALTIMORE HARBOR".

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 1 and 2; in lines 3 and 5, strike "(9)" and "(10)", respectively, and substitute "(8)" and "(9)", respectively.

On page 5, in lines 20 and 24, in each instance, strike "WITHIN 5 MILES OF A RESIDENTIAL OVERBURDENED COMMUNITY" and substitute "FROM JUNE 1, 2025, THROUGH MAY 31, 2029, BOTH INCLUSIVE"; in line 26, strike "October" and substitute "June"; and in the same line, after "2025." insert "It shall remain effective for

a period of 4 years and, at the end of May 31, 2029, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
