On page 11, in line 2, strike "<u>ADD ADDITIONAL WILDLAND ACREAGE</u>" and substitute "<u>ACQUIRE AND REPLACE THE TYPE 1 STATE WILDLAND ACREAGE THAT</u> <u>IS LOST AS A RESULT OF THE TRANSMISSION LINE WITH ACREAGE THAT IS TWICE</u> <u>THE SIZE AND IS SUITABLE FOR DESIGNATION AS WILDLAND ACREAGE, AND TO</u> <u>DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A LAND CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE</u> <u>AREA AFFECTED BY THE TRANSMISSION LINE THAT SUPPORTS WILDLIFE</u> <u>HABITATS</u>"; after line 6, insert:

"<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That this Act shall not abrogate an existing right of public participation in statute or regulations.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) Section 1 of this Act is contingent on:

(1) <u>a 120-day stakeholder process that includes:</u>

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(i) <u>a public participation process that meets the requirements of</u> <u>COMAR 20.79.01;</u>

(ii) <u>at least one public advertised meeting within 25 miles of each</u> impacted designated wildland area;

(iii) <u>at least one public meeting that provides for virtual</u> <u>participation;</u>

(iv) special effort on the part of an applicant to reach out to organizations with special expertise in wildlands, wildlife management, and environmental stewardship; and

(v) <u>a portal for public comments, which must be submitted to the</u> <u>Department of Natural Resources;</u>

(2) <u>a 90-day deliberation period by the Department of Natural</u> <u>Resources; and</u>

(3) <u>a recommendation by the Secretary of Natural Resources that the</u> <u>Public Service Commission issue a certificate of public convenience and necessity for a</u> <u>proposed transmission line.</u>

(b) <u>The Commission shall notify the Department of Legislative Services within</u> <u>5 days after the criteria under subsection (a) of this section have been met.</u>";

in line 7, strike "<u>3.</u>" and substitute "<u>5.</u>"; in line 20, strike "<u>4.</u>" and substitute "<u>6.</u>"; and in the same line, after "That" insert "<u>, subject to Section 4 of this Act.</u>".
