AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 429, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2 of the bill, in line 9, after "date;" insert "requiring the Department, in consultation with the Accountability and Implementation Board, to convene a certain workgroup to study the long-term sustainability of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 63 of the bill, before line 12, insert:

"SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) The State Department of Education, in collaboration with the Accountability and Implementation Board, shall convene a workgroup to study the long-term sustainability of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future based on its existing mandates and costs.

(b) The study of the workgroup shall:

(1) include relevant State and local education stakeholders, including local governments, local education agency leadership, employee organizations, and any other participants necessary to fully represent the interests of public education;

(2) assess:

(i) the existing policy mandates on local education agencies and an updated fiscal estimate of the mandates on State and local government; and

- (ii) whether the projected funding is sufficient to provide an adequate and equitable education for all children in the State, including an analysis of historical and projected inflationary impacts; and
- (3) take into consideration all components of funding education, including transportation, building maintenance, operating and capital funds for school security, health services, food services, and employee and retiree health benefits.
- (c) On or before November 15, 2025, the State Department of Education shall submit the findings and any recommendations of the study to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.".

On page 33 of the Budget and Taxation Committee Amendments (SB0429/543528/1), in the fifth line from the bottom of Amendment No. 13, strike "10." and substitute "11.".
