- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Correctional Services

17 (A) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2026, AND EACH OCTOBER 1 THEREAFTER, 18 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE LOCATION OF INDIVIDUALS 19 BEFORE AND FOLLOWING INCARCERATION IN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY 20 AND REPORT THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY TO THE SENATE JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS 21 COMMITTEE, THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE, THE HOUSE 22 JUDICIARY COMMITTEE, AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE, IN 23 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

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THE STUDY SHALL INCLUDE:

2 (1) DATA ON THE COUNTY OF RESIDENCE OF EACH INDIVIDUAL 3 RELEASED DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR, AS REPORTED BY THE INDIVIDUAL ON 4 INTAKE TO THE FACILITY;

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(2) DATA ON THE COUNTY OF RELEASE FOLLOWING INCARCERATION;

6 (3) FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO WERE TRANSFERRED FROM ONE STATE 7 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TO ANOTHER PRIOR TO RELEASE, THE NUMBER OF DAYS 8 THAT THE TRANSFER OCCURRED BEFORE RELEASE; AND

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(4) A COMPARISON OF:

10 (I) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS RELEASED FROM A STATE 11 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY INTO THE SAME COUNTY IN WHICH THEY RESIDED PRIOR 12 TO INCARCERATION;

13(II) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS RELEASED FROM A STATE14CORRECTIONAL FACILITY INTO THE SAME COUNTY IN WHICH CONVICTION15OCCURRED; AND

16 (III) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS RELEASED FROM A STATE 17 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY INTO THE COUNTY IN WHICH THEY WERE INCARCERATED 18 AT THE TIME OF RELEASE.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2025.
