the Department of State Police as required by the Department of State Police;
requiring the Department of State Police to adopt procedures for the collection of
information from local law enforcement agencies; and generally relating to missing
person cases.

19(A) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL COLLECT AND PUBLISH ON20ITS WEBSITE INFORMATION ON MISSING PERSON REPORTS IN THE STATE.

21 **(B)** THE INFORMATION PUBLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION **(A)** OF THIS 22 SECTION SHALL:

5 (C) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT OF 6 STATE POLICE SHALL PUBLISH ON ITS WEBSITE A SUMMARY OF ALL INFORMATION 7 ON MISSING PERSON REPORTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION FOR THE 8 PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR.

9 (D) EACH LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL PROVIDE THE 10 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE WITH INFORMATION REGARDING ANY MISSING 11 PERSON WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE AGENCY AS REQUIRED BY THE 12 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.

13 (E) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL ADOPT PROCEDURES 14 NECESSARY FOR THE COLLECTION OF INFORMATION PROVIDED BY LOCAL LAW 15 ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2026.
