## School Construction and Housing – School Zones and Adequate Public Facilities Ordinances

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 5 (A) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2025, AND EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL SUBMIT A STUDENT RESIDENCY AND SCHOOL ZONES REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION ON
- 8 SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION.
- 9 (B) (1) THE STUDENT RESIDENCY AND SCHOOL ZONES REPORT SHALL
- 10 **INCLUDE:**
- 11 (I) THE SCHOOL ZONE BOUNDARIES AND ATTENDANCE AREA
- 12 MAP; AND
- 13 (II) THE LOCATIONS OF EACH STUDENT'S RESIDENCE.
- 14 (2) THE REPORT MAY NOT INCLUDE ANY PERSONAL IDENTIFYING
- 15 INFORMATION OF ANY STUDENT.
- 16 (C) THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION SHALL
- 17 ADOPT REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING FORMATTING AND SUBMISSION
- 18 REQUIREMENTS FOR THE STUDENT RESIDENCY AND SCHOOL ZONES REPORT.
