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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Health – Cannabis Public Health Advisory Council – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Cannabis Public Health Advisory  
4 Council; and generally relating to the Cannabis Public Health Advisory Council.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Health – General**

18 13–4502.

19 (a) There is a Cannabis Public Health Advisory Council.

20 (b) The Advisory Council consists of the following members:

- 1                   (1)    One member from the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President  
2 of the Senate;
- 3                   (2)    One member from the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of  
4 the House;
- 5                   (3)    The Secretary, or the Secretary's designee;
- 6                   (4)    The Deputy Secretary for Behavioral Health, or the Deputy Secretary's  
7 designee;
- 8                   (5)    The Secretary of Agriculture, or the Secretary's designee;
- 9                   (6)    The Executive Director of the [Natalie M. LaPrade Medical Cannabis  
10 Commission] **MARYLAND CANNABIS ADMINISTRATION**, or the Executive Director's  
11 designee;
- 12                   (7)    The State Superintendent of Schools, or the State Superintendent's  
13 designee;
- 14                   (8)    The Executive Director of the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention  
15 and Policy, or the Executive Director's designee; [and]
- 16                   (9)    **THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE**  
17 **ADMINISTRATION, OR THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESIGNEE; AND**
- 18                   **(10)** The following members appointed by the Governor:
- 19                   (i)    One representative from a historically black college or  
20 university;
- 21                   (ii)   One health care provider with experience in cannabis;
- 22                   (iii)  One pharmacist licensed in the State;
- 23                   (iv)   One health care provider with expertise in substance use  
24 disorder treatment and recovery;
- 25                   (v)    One individual with expertise in cannabis use disorder;
- 26                   (vi)   One academic researcher with expertise in cannabis law and  
27 policy;
- 28                   (vii)  One individual with at least 5 years of experience in health or  
29 social equity;

1 (viii) One public health professional with cannabis experience; and

2 (ix) One representative of a laboratory that tests cannabis.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
4 October 1, 2025.
