- 1 (1) PROHIBIT A STUDENT FROM USING A CELLULAR PHONE DURING 2 INSTRUCTIONAL TIME; AND
- 3 (2) REQUIRE A STUDENT TO STORE THE STUDENT'S CELLULAR 4 PHONE IN A SECURE PLACE DURING INSTRUCTIONAL TIME, INCLUDING:
- 5 (I) A LOCKER;
- 6 (II) A CLOSED BACKPACK; OR
- 7 (III) A STORAGE CONTAINER PROVIDED BY THE SCHOOL.
