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ARTICLE, PHYSICAL

1 (j) Money expended from the Fund for testing of sexual assault evidence 2 collection kits is supplemental to and is not intended to take the place of funding that 3 otherwise would be appropriated for testing of sexual assault evidence collection kits.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2025.
