HOUSE BILL 61

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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**Article – Education** 

4 <del>5-331.</del>

5 FOR EACH CONSTRUCTION PROJECT OR MAJOR RENOVATION PROJECT OF A 6 PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDING PROPOSED AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2025, THAT INCLUDES 7 THE CONSTRUCTION OR RENOVATION OF A SCHOOL PARKING LOT, THE STATE 8 SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE PROJECT BE DESIGNED, ENGINEERED, AND 9 CONSTRUCTED IN A MANNER SO THAT THE PARKING LOT IS EQUIPPED WITH THE 10 APPROPRIATE UNDERGROUND INFRASTRUCTURE NECESSARY TO SUPPORT SOLAR 11 CANOPY INSTALLATION.

12 <u>5–319.</u>

(a) <u>The Interagency Commission shall adopt regulations that require the design</u>
<u>development documents for the construction or major renovation of school buildings</u>
<u>submitted by a county board to the Interagency Commission to include:</u>

16(1)An evaluation of the use of solar technologies, including photovoltaic or17solar water heating AND PARKING LOT SOLAR CANOPIES, based on life cycle costs; and

18 (2) If an evaluation determines that solar technologies are not appropriate 19 for a construction or major renovation project, a report that explains why the use of the 20 technology is not appropriate.

(b) On or before December 31 of each year, the Interagency Commission shall
submit a report on the number of public school construction and major renovation projects
in each jurisdiction that use solar technologies to the Governor and, in accordance with §
2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
