17 WHEREAS, Community health workers are frontline public health workers and
18 intermediaries between social services and the underserved communities that need access
19 to crucial health care resources; and

1 WHEREAS, Community health workers play invaluable roles in our public health
2 care system and in Maryland's diverse communities; and

3 WHEREAS, Community health workers utilize vital cultural and linguistic skills to
4 better serve communities across Maryland in effective, culturally specific ways; and

5 WHEREAS, Community health workers share resources and education about
6 disease prevention and management and help to remove obstacles to community members'
7 health and wellness; and

8 WHEREAS, Community health workers address the social determinants of health
9 and improve health outcomes for low-income, underrepresented, and underserved
10 communities; and

11 WHEREAS, Community health workers strive to ensure that every Marylander has
12 the opportunity to attain their highest level of health; now, therefore,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That Section(s) 7-410 through 7-421 of Article – General Provisions of the Annotated Code
15 of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7-411 through 7-422, respectively.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
17 as follows:

18 **Article – General Provisions**

19 **7-410.**

20 **(A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM MAY 8 AS COMMUNITY**
21 **HEALTH WORKER APPRECIATION DAY.**

22 **(B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL**
23 **ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS WITH INFORMATIVE**
24 **PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.**

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 2025.
