- WHEREAS, Community health workers play invaluable roles in our public health care system and in Maryland's diverse communities; and
- WHEREAS, Community health workers utilize vital cultural and linguistic skills to better serve communities across Maryland in effective, culturally specific ways; and
- WHEREAS, Community health workers share resources and education about disease prevention and management and help to remove obstacles to community members' health and wellness; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Community health workers address the social determinants of health 9 and improve health outcomes for low–income, underrepresented, and underserved 10 communities; and
- WHEREAS, Community health workers strive to ensure that every Marylander has the opportunity to attain their highest level of health; now, therefore,
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 7–410 through 7–421 of Article – General Provisions of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–411 through 7–422, respectively.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article General Provisions
- 19 **7-410.**
- 20 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM MAY 8 AS COMMUNITY 21 HEALTH WORKER APPRECIATION DAY.
- 22 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 23 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS WITH INFORMATIVE 24 PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
